Care Tips

Water (Frequency):

Once per day. It is recommended that watering is done in the early mornings or late evenings.

Pruning (Frequency):

Prune to maintain desirable shape and size.

Common Pests and Treatments:

In case of an attack by chewing insects, your plant may be treated with the following insecticides:

- Actara
- NeemX
- Pegasus

****Be guided by manufacturers' directions for use of the insecticides.***

- **Ornamental:** Planted widely in urban areas. Suitable for use as windbreaks.
